Pancoast tumors are pulmonary neoplasms located in the superior sulcus of the lung. [8,9] On chest radiographs, these tumors may appear as a unilateral apical opacity (arrow) or an apical asymmetry. [8,9] Local rib destruction, particularly of the first rib, may also be present. Lordotic chest views may be helpful to clarify a suspected lesion.

Key Messages. The chronic hyperglycemia of diabetes is associated with significant long-term microvascular and cardiovascular complications. A fasting plasma glucose of  $\geq 7.0$  mmol/L, a 2-hour plasma glucose value in a 75 g oral glucose tolerance test of  $\geq 11.1$  mmol/L or a glycosylated hemoglobin (A1C) of  $\geq 6.5\%$  can predict the development of retinopathy.
