Headings and subheadings are formatted this way in the Chicago style paper format: A Chicago style paper heading can be written in all caps. If you want, you can write subheadings in separate lines, but no full stops on ends. The number of subheading levels should not exceed three.

Double-space the text of the paper. Use left-justified text, which will have a ragged right edge. Do not use fully (newspaper-style) justified text. Use a 1/2" indent for paragraph beginnings, block quotes and hanging (bibliography) indents. Number the pages in the top right corner of the paper, beginning with the

first page of text.
