Meccano, the dinky toy and  
Scalextric. And yet, until  
now, there has been no  
biography of this  
extraordinary figure. Frank  
Hornby lived in Liverpool,  
and while working as a  
bookkeeper for a meat  
importer, he became  
frustrated by the range of  
toys in Britain and set up a  
toy manufacturing company.  
A passionate and inspired  
man, he developed his first  
toys for his own children and  
by his death in 1936
